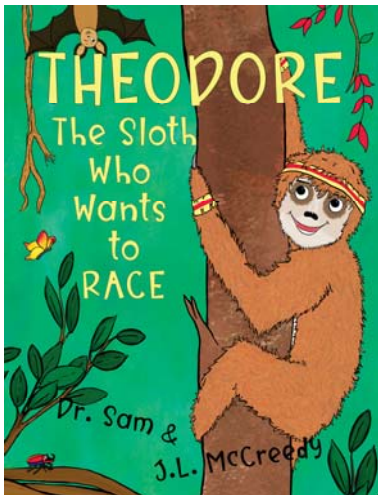


New Children’s Book “Theodore, The Sloth Who Wants to Race” Inspires Big Dreams and Bigger Laughs
